LOCATION AND TRAVEL

Sealarks is a secluded campsite where you have sole use of the site. It is situated at the far east of Seaford in the South Downs National Park.

Buses run regularly to Eastbourne and Brighton from bus stops just a 10 minutes walk from the site. The train station is about a 30 minute walk away with regular services to Lewes where you can change trains to travel along the coast or directly to London.

The site started life as a sand pit and was then taken over by the General Post Office. The GPO built a telephone repeater station to act as a terminal point for cross channel cables going out to Rouen and Paris. Seahaven Division bought the site which was officially opened as Sealarks Campsite on 7th June 1987.

FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT

SEATING

Outside we have a campfire circle and 6 picnic benches which can be moved to suit your preference.

Inside there are 18 go-pack tables and plenty of chairs

KITCHEN / CATERING

Our modern kitchen is fully equipped with:

- dual fuel range cooker
- large fridge freezer
- microwave
- instant boiled water and kettle
- sink and handwashing





The catering store room has lots of:

- pots and pans
- bowls
- jugs
- cutlery
- utensils
- chopping boards
- trays





There is also a small chest freezer, large gas BBQ, 4 patrol altar fires and patrol cooking utensils.



There is also a double catering sink outside with hot and cold running water.

We try to maintain a supply of wood for campfires and some patrol cooking but this is not guaranteed. Logs can be purchased and delivered locally if required.



BATHROOMS

The main bathroom has:

- 2 flush toilets
- 2 basins in cubicles
- 2 hand wash basins
- 2 showers

There is also a separate disabled toilet and basin. Toilet roll, hand soap and paper towels are all provided.





SHOPPING

There is a Morrison's supermarket within a 5 minutes drive and also a Tesco Express and Co-op convenience store. Seaford town has a good variety of other shops too.

Seaford museum is housed in Martello Tower number 74. The museum records Seaford's long history from its days as a Cinque Port.

There is a General Store, Dressmakers parlour, the contents of toy, chemist, ironmonger and photographer's shops, a Victorian schoolroom and a Victorian and wartime kitchen.
